Our Network is now coordinated!

After one year of development, we decided the time has come to introduce some structure in our team to be more efficient. We elected a coordination team for the Alumni Network:

- PR responsible: Gregoire Toussaint (Alumni LBG Grenoble)

These alumni will work together with the rest of the <u>AlumniNet@BEST.eu.org</u> group. They will try to make that the next half year becomes successful time for BEST Alumni. AlumniNet will make the network grow by focussing on two main axes: IT and PR.

Concerning IT, AlumniNet will maintain the existing applications and develop new features and applications for BEST Alumni. The PR group will focus on promotion among alumni and BEST-members, so that more BESTies join the Alumni Network and also the AlumniNet group grows stronger.

Outcomes of the London meeting

This March the first, officially organised, alumni working meeting took place in London. In true BEST spirit, partying hard (cocktails!) was combined with working hard and focusing on concrete outcomes. Priorities were set as:

- development of IT features for alumni
- promotion of the various channels available to reach out and connect BEST alumni.

A new alumni welcome page for the Private Area was designed just before GA and is now online, offering immediate access to the member search engine, listing of alumni-oriented events, alumni news and more. A step beyond the welcome page, the Alumni Profile feature was recently launched. Here alumni can provide their personal and professional information, so that you can look up old friends or find BEST alumni paidbours.

Another addressed issue was the reorganisation of the alumni mailing lists. You will hear more about this before this summer.

Moreover, various PR activities were planned to promote the available services to BEST Alumni. These include this newsletter, informing at BEST General Meetings, and more, that you will discover soon (it wouldn't be BEST if these plans didn't also include t-shirts!).

Finally, questions regarding the structure of the group developing these features were also treated, including the creation of an action plan for the coming months.
